REGISTRATION PROCEDURES & DATES

Regular registration will be conducted during business hours beginning December 3rd with extended hours on Wednesday and Thursday, January 2 and 3, 9:30 a.m.-7:00 p.m. **Students registering after January 3rd will be considered "late" registrants and will incur a late fee. This includes registrations for all Module A, B, and Apples of Gold courses.**

Registration forms may be downloaded and printed from the website by tabbing "Courses & Schedules" and then "Registration Forms."

Returning students may register in person, by mail, by phone, or on the website. Any and all registration activity must include complete information on the registration form and be accompanied by the appropriate payment for fees and tuition.

Returning students paying 100% of fees and tuition may utilize any registration method. Registration on the website allows for payment by PayPal or credit card and must cover the entire bill.

All students using the Carver Payment Plan may register in person, by mail, or over the phone with payment by credit card. No phone registrations will be taken without accompanying payment.

New students must complete an application prior to registration. College and Seminary applications should be submitted by **Friday, December 21** for admittance. Late applications may affect the admittance and/or the registration process. After admittance, new students should contact the Admissions/Registrar's Office to schedule an appointment for registration.
