REGULAR REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Regular registration will be conducted during business hours beginning Monday, November 30 thru Thursday, January 7. **Students registering after January 7 will be considered "late" registrants and will incur a late fee. This includes registrations for all Module A, B, and Apples of Gold courses.**

RETURNING STUDENTS

Returning students from the last two semesters are encouraged to register through the OasisSis (Student Information System), even for those on the payment plan. Registration is also available by phone, by mail, or in person by appointment. Registration forms may be downloaded and printed from the website by tabbing "Courses & Schedules" and then "Registration Forms."

Any and all registration activity (using any method) must include complete information on the registration form and be accompanied by the appropriate payment for fees and tuition.

NEW STUDENTS

New Students must submit a completed application with personal testimony and application fee prior to registration. **College and Seminary applications should be submitted by Thursday, January 7, 2021 for proper processing.** Requests for applications and information may be submitted to the Administrative Offices through the Carver's website: www.carverbiblecollegekc.org, by phone (816-333-1577, Ext. 7101), or in person by appointment. Late applications may affect the admittance and/or the registration process.

After admittance, new students must contact the Admissions/Registrar's Office to schedule an appointment for advising and registration.
