REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Regular registration will be conducted during business hours beginning July 19 with extended hours on Wednesday and Thursday, August 4 and August 5, 9:30 a.m.-7:00 p.m. **Students registering after August 5 will be considered "late" registrants and will incur a late fee. This includes registrations for all Module A courses.**

RETURNING STUDENTS

Returning students from the last two semesters are encouraged to register through OasisSis, (Student Information System), even for those on the payment plan. Registration is also available in person, by mail, or by phone. Registration forms may be downloaded and printed from the website by tabbing "Courses & Schedules" and then "Registration Forms."

Any and all registration activity (using any method) must include complete information on the registration form and will only be finalized with appropriate payment for fees and tuition.

NEW STUDENTS

New Students must submit a completed application with personal testimony and application fee prior to registration. **College and Seminary applications should be submitted by Thursday, August 5, 2021 for proper processing.** Requests for the online application and information may be submitted to the Administrative Offices through the Carver website: www.carverbiblecollegekc.org, by phone (816-333-1577, Ext. 7101), or in person. Late applications may affect the admittance and/or the registration process.

After admittance, **new students should contact the Admissions/Registrar's Office to register.** If you qualify for our tuition payment plan, all fees and 25% of tuition are due at the time of registration by Aug. 5. Remaining monthly payments are due on the 1st of each month through November.

PAYMENT PLAN

Tuition Discounts Offset Fall 2021-2022 Tuition Increase

The progress of Carver's ten-year plan toward its full accreditation has been notable and encouraging. Many changes and enhancements have been made in curriculum, administrative procedures, technology, student involvement, assessment, evaluation, and strategic planning. An important part of this plan is the progression of Carver's financial strength to enable it to grow both now and into the future.

This progression brings us to the point of a necessary

tuition increase. The increase in tuition has been structured to provide offsetting discounts for new and returning students who are actively registered and continuing in their programs during the 2021-2022 Fall and Spring semesters.

The net effect of these discounts will be to hold this year's tuition cost for qualified new and continuing students to the pre-increase levels of last year. We praise the Lord for His provision to make these discounts possible.

FALL CLASSES IN-PERSON, ON ZOOM, OR BLENDED

We are pleased to announce that, pending acceptable pandemic conditions, Carver will conduct its Fall 2021 classes through several different delivery methods including: "in-person," "Zoom only," or "blended" with Zoom students joining "in-person" classes.

All published courses should be considered "in-person" unless otherwise designated. Start time for Zoom classes is Central (CST) Time. College course tuition will be determined by credit hour irrespective of the delivery mode.
